JUNIOR WINTER LEAGUE

“GENERAL RULES”

- 1) All participants are required to read and follow the Rules of Trapshooting Etiquette.
- 2) Each 25-Target Event is to be shot “Cold Gun” (no practice rounds shot prior to event.)
- 3) All participants will shoot their first round from the 16-yard line; thereafter, participants will shoot the yardage matching their last score, not closer than 16 yards.

Sub Jr. Shooters will be allowed to shoot from a shorter yardage until their scores and abilities reach a level of consistency justifying a move farther back in yardage.

- 4) Participants must shoot a minimum of 4 rounds (100 targets) in each half of the League Schedule to be eligible for year end awards and trophies.
- 5) There will be an opportunity to shoot a maximum of 2 make-up rounds per each half of the League Schedule. The first round shot (The “Cold Gun” round) will be recorded for the day of the round and used to determine the yardage to be shot at the next scheduled shoot day. The second (make-up) round will be recorded for a date that was previously missed.

***Note:** During a make-up round is the only time the “Cold Gun” rule is modified.
